## WATCH AND ACT MESSAGE DAMAGING WINDS

The State Emergency Service advises that Damaging or locally Destructive Winds are likely to impact exposed or elevated parts of the state south of Port Pirie overnight. Residents are advised to stay indoors, away from windows while these storms are occurring. Minor structural damage is possible. You are in danger from flying debris, falling trees and downed powerlines. Roads may be dangerous, do not travel unless absolutely necessary.
