

PET EMERGENCY KIT

Many evacuation centres do not allow pets, so you should try to have a plan where you can accommodate your pet if necessary. A friend or relative who knows your pet is a good option, however your local council may know of a place nearby which would be out of the flood region. Prepare a list of people or places that can assist you with your pet and keep it in your emergency kit.

Your pet will need:

- Pet food, bowl and treats in cans or waterproof containers
- Drinkable water in plastic bottles
- Can opener for canned food
- Pet medications and medical records in a waterproof container
- Sturdy leashes, harnesses and/or carriers so you can move your pets safely and they can't escape (remember they may be scared and may act different than usual)
- Current photos of your pet in case they get lost
- The name of your veterinarian
- Pet beds and toys, if there is room.

All your pets should have an identification tag and collar if possible.
