FLOOD WATCH AND ACT CANCELLATION

Time Message Issued: 22:45 hours

Date Message Issued: 14/02/2014

SES advises that a heavy rain event across the Mid-North districts this evening has passed. The risk of flooding to areas bounded by Clare, Balaklava, Hamley Bridge and Eudunda, including the towns of Auburn, Saddleworth, Riverton and Kapunda has significantly reduced and the Flood Watch and Act notification has been cancelled.

While the immediate threat of flash flooding has decreased the SES urges people to use extreme caution when in the vicinity of fast flowing water.

The public should continue to monitor local conditions. The SES will provide targeted Advice or Emergency Warnings should the need arise.

A Severe Thunderstorm Warning for damaging wind and heavy rainfall for people in the North East Pastoral and parts of the Flinders and North West Pastoral districts remains current.

SES advises you should:

- not drive, ride or walk through flood water
- keep children and yourself clear of creeks and storm drains.
