The public is urged to closely monitor the media for updates on the risk of flash flooding.

The public will be provided targeted emergency warnings should the likelihood of flash flooding increase or flash flooding occur.

The SES is distributing sandbags today between 11am and 1pm to home and business owners who may be impacted by the severe weather. Details can be found on the SES website www.ses.sa.gov.au.

SES advises you should:

- not drive, ride or walk through floodwater
- keep children and yourself clear of creeks and storm drains, and
- stay indoors, away from windows, while conditions are severe.
