# WATCH AND ACT

SES advises that widespread heavy rain has resulted in an elevated risk of flash flooding in a number of areas in the state. There is also a risk of destructive winds and hail.

Locations which may be affected include; the Riverland, Murraylands, Upper South East and the Mid North.

This is not a warning. It is advice of an elevated risk of flash flooding.

The public is urged to closely monitor the media for updates on the risk of flash flooding.

The public will be provided targeted Emergency Warnings should the likelihood of flash flooding increase or flash flooding occurs.

Check and follow your Emergency Flood Plan and prepare for flooding in your area. If your plan is to leave or you are not prepared, leave now.

SES advises you should:

- not drive, ride or walk through floodwater
- keep children and yourself clear of creeks and storm drains, and
- stay indoors, away from windows, while conditions are severe.
