SEVERE WEATHER ADVICE

SES advises that the Bureau of Meteorology has forecast heavy rains and winds across large parts of South Australia from this afternoon. This may result in localised flooding and storm related damage in Adelaide and the Hills regions.

The public is urged to closely monitor the media for updates on the risk of flash flooding.

The public will be provided targeted emergency warnings should the likelihood of flash flooding increase or flash flooding occur.

SES advises you should:

- Not drive, ride or walk through floodwater
- Keep children and yourself clear of creeks and storm drains, and
- Stay indoors, away from windows, while conditions are severe.
