FLOOD EMERGENCY WARNING

The State Emergency Service advises that a dam has burst north of Greenock, which may cause flooding of properties and roads in Greenock Township.

People in the Greenock area are urged to closely monitor local conditions for the risk of flooding.

Check and follow your Emergency Flood Plan and prepare for flooding in your area. Move items of value to a safe place. If your plan is to leave or you are not prepared, consider leaving now.

Only leave if you are certain that the path is clear to a safer place.

SES advises that residents of the warning area that floodwaters may rise rapidly and are likely to be fast moving. You should never walk, ride or drive through floodwater or allow children to play in or near floodwater.
