## FLOOD WATCH AND ACT MESSAGE

The State Emergency Service advises that there is an elevated flood risk to the township of Port Wakefield due to recent heavy rainfall and increased river flows, which may threaten the safety of you and your family.

People living or travelling through these areas are urged to stay alert, monitor conditions and stay tuned to your local radio station for updates.

Check and follow your Emergency Flood Plan and prepare for flooding in your area. Be aware that floodwaters may rise rapidly and are likely to be fast moving. You should never walk, ride or drive through floodwater or allow children to play in or near floodwater. If your plan is to leave, if you require time to leave or if you are not prepared, you should consider leaving now.

**Only leave if you are certain that the road is clear to a safer place.**
