FLOOD WATCH AND ACT MESSAGE

The State Emergency Service advises that flooding in the Angas and Bremer catchments, including Langhorne Creek and Strathalbyn is stabilising, but threats may still be present.

Although flood waters are no longer rising, significant amounts of water are still present which may threaten the safety of you and your family.

Continue to follow your Emergency Flood Plan. Do not walk, ride or drive through floodwater or let children play in or near floodwater. Take care while driving as mud, tree branches and other debris may still be on roads or the road surface may be damaged.

If you live or travel through these areas, stay alert and continue to monitor local radio for updates on the situation.

If your property has been flooded do not turn your electricity back on until it has been checked by a qualified electrician and be aware that your household water supply may not be safe.
