FLOOD WATCH AND ACT MESSAGE

The State Emergency Service advises that flooding in Port Wakefield is stabilising. Although flood waters are no longer rising, significant amounts of water are still present which may threaten the safety of you and your family.

A small increase in levels is expected later this evening, after the high tide period has passed, which is not expected to result in further flooding. In addition, a number of roads are closed and access is limited. The situation is constantly changing and the public are advised to avoid the area.

People living in these areas are urged to check and follow their Emergency Flood Plan and closely monitor conditions. Do not walk, ride or drive through floodwater or let children play in or near floodwater. Stay tuned to local radio for updates on the situation.
