FLOOD WATCH AND ACT MESSAGE

The State Emergency Service advises that, following more rain this morning, levels will increase in the Gawler River overnight. These levels may cause flooding and there is also a possibility that temporary repairs to levees and river banks may give way. It is very important that residents of these areas remain vigilant overnight for flooding.

You are urged to closely monitor local conditions and listen to ABC radio for updates. Put your Emergency Flood Plan into action. Prepare your family and home for flooding in your area. Move items of value to a safe place.

You should never walk, ride or drive through floodwater or allow children to play in or near floodwater.

Avoid unnecessary travel in these areas. Please do not enter these areas as roads are likely to be dangerous or blocked and access will be restricted.

For SES assistance during floods, phone 132 500. If the matter is life threatening call triple zero.
